**AFFIDAVIT**

The undersigned upon oath deposes and states as follows, to-wit:

That the AFFIANT is employed by the Norman Police Department. That on or about the **16 th** day of **June**, at **2400 Blk of West Main Street, Norman**, Cleveland County, Oklahoma, the undersigned further states as follows:

On the above date Norman Police and the District 21 Drug Task Force were conducting surveillance on 1609 Rowena Lane. Detectives observed Norman NERO and Joseph KUNKEL exit the house carrying a box. KUNKEL placed the box into the back seat of the truck. SID Detectives followed NERO and KUNKEL until Detective Sumner stopped NERO for a traffic violation in the 2400 block of West Main Street. Detective Morgan ran his certified K-9 (KILO) around the truck while Detective Sumner was conducting his traffic stop. KILO alerted to the odor of narcotics in the truck. A search of the truck revealed a glass marijuana pipe. The box that KUNKEL placed into the back seat of the truck contained two large Ziploc bags both containing a total of two pounds of mushrooms. KUNKEL and NERO were arrested and transported to the Norman Investigation Center. Detective Morgan completed a search warrant for KUNKEL's house at 1609 Rowena Lane and Judge Stice reviewed and signed the warrant. Detective Morgan served the warrant and found large crates containing several large bags of mushrooms in each (estimated total of 8 pounds), marijuana, edible marijuana candy, approximately \$4,000.00 USC stored with the drugs, baggies, scales and mushroom growing equipment. 1609 Rowena Lane is within 1000' of Whitter Middle School and Rotary Park. KUNKEL was transported to the Cleveland county Justice Center for the following charges:

- Possession of CDS (mushrooms schedule 1) with Intent to Distribute in concert with NERO**
- Possession of CDS (mushrooms schedule 1) with Intent to Distribute w/in 2000' of a school**
- Possession of CDS (marijuana) within 1000' of a school**
- Possession of Drug Proceeds**
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia**
